"I need your help to build a new amusement park", says Freddy. "Of course", agree Max Mouse and Lucy Lamb.


Max puts two window-walls down, counting six knobs from the back of each base plate.





Lucy adds two yellow fences to the edge of the window-walls.

Freddy and Max put a tall yellow pillar on top of each little fence.




Then three flat blue plates fit on top of the windows and pillars. "This is easy", Lucy smiles.

They add two yellow bricks on each side, first a square, then a bigger brick.




On top of that go two blue window-walls.




"Where do these big blue pieces go?" asks Lucy.

"They snap right on top to hold the ferris wheel", Freddy explains, "You'll see ..."

[&]quot;Then the yellow bricks, just like before", Freddy directs them.




- A Now Freddy and Max fit a big yellow wheel on the axle rod.
- B "Help me with the red seat, Max". Freddy and Max fit a red basket seat through the holes in the wheel.
- C Two ... Three ... Four seats are ready.
- D Finally, they snap the last big yellow wheel in place. "It is important that we get the suspension for the basketseats in between the holes of the yellow wheel before we snap it tightly on to the axle rod", says Freddy to Max. "Yes", says Max, "or else the wheel won't go round properly".




Then they press the ferris wheel firmly on the two big blue pieces.

"We must make sure no dirt gets in, or the wheel will get stuck", warns Freddy as he gives the wheel a test spin.




Lucy helps move a red staircase into place.

"That's where they go up", says Freddy. "The long red slide is how they get down." They lock the steps and slide carefully in place, one knob from the front.



Lucy worries, "Someone can fall down from the platform!" so she snaps two white fences on the front.

Freddy and Max put four yellow fences down below.



Now they start making an entrance gate to the boat. Together they put two yellow pillars and a big brick in place. "Got to control the crowds", Freddy says, always the businessman.

Max climbs up to finish the entrance gate with a long flat blue plate and a special yellow brick. "Fine", Lucy says, "this clearly shows the entrance to the boat."



"Must'nt forget the prize booth", Freddy tells Max and Lucy. First they take an open chest. Next, they place a big square blue plate on top so it sticks out by two knobs. Two white pillars rise from the blue plate, then a red curved piece goes on top. Lucy Lamb clicks the prizes in place.

"I'd love the doll's house", she sighs. "How can I win one?"



"Play the Wheel of Fortune!" Freddy says.

- A Freddy builds a roulette wheel, starting with two small red bricks and one longer brick.
- B On top, he puts a big flat red plate.
 Next, he puts a square brick in front.
- C "Out of my way!" Freddy lowers the round number wheel. "It looks like a little parasol! How cute!" says Lucy as they snap it carefully. Then they add another red square to the front.
- D Freddy puts the arrow on top.
 Lucy adds the numbers: one, two, three, four.



The Wheel of Fortune and prize booth are moved into place.




Freddy and Max count thirteen knobs from the end of the base plate then line up the tall axle rod on the back. "Good work", says Freddy.

They drop down a wheel for the base of the merry-go-round.




Now everyone goes to work putting on coloured square plates to hold the seats. "I won't need a baseplate for this big blue seat though", says Max. "How's that?"



VROOM!! Freddy rides up on a motorcycle. "This will make a great merry-go-round seat!" he grins. He adds a blue round brick on the square blue plate to make it safe. Then Fred snaps the cycle tightly into place.

Lucy plops a wash-tub on another square for a very silly seat.




Max adds a ship's steering wheel to the red square with two tiny red bricks. "Yo-ho-ho! Captain Wilfred will love it!" Freddy laughs.

It takes all three to help put the red merry-go-round top into place.




"I love to go rowing", says Lucy, so Max and Freddy build a boat.

- A Max puts a little white brick on each side of the rowboat.
- B Then Freddy stacks a flat white plate for the seat, Lucy locks the oars in place, CLICK! CLICK!



AMUSEMENT PARK






In no time at all, Mike Monkey, the driver, calls, "Everybody out! Last stop! The FABULAND® Amusement Park!"

Clive guesses number four but the spinning wheel stops on three. "Sorry, Clive, you lose. Better luck next time. Now get to work."





"Clean the ferris wheel so it doesn't get stuck," warns the fox.


"Not much chance of that. I'll do it tomorrow," the lazy crocodile decides.

Clive tries his luck again but he still doesn't win.


"What can I do to surprise her?" Clive wonders.




He runs to the lake, smiling his best big toothy smile. Clumsily, Clive pulls Lucy out of the rowboat.

"Yeoww! Help me down!" he cries, forgetting to be brave and strong.




Freddy and Max turn the big wheel so Lucy gets down.
